

Partnering With Parents

There are 636 weekends left of your children's lives with you by the time they are in kindergarten. How are you spending the weekends? We want to partner with you to help you develop virtues in your children's lives. The friends your children spend time with will ultimately determine the direction of their life! We want to join with you to build those relationships that help you direct your children's lives. So ... what are you going to do with your weekends? Let's work together to build the basics of Luke 2:52 virtues into your children's lives. You will receive a "Parents' Page" to help you reinforce the virtues during the week. The "3 Basic Truths" Taught

1. *Wisdom*: I need to make wise choices
2. *Faith*: I can trust God no matter what.
3. *Friendship*: I should treat others the way I want to be treated.

The curriculum is designed to provoke discovery and invite kids into a new understanding of how to grow in relationship with Jesus. It includes 150 Bible stories and is based on core virtues and memory verses monthly.

The Time-Frame

Each Sunday, there are three components, each targeted to a particular type of learning and relational environment:

- **POWER UP**—begins our session with children coming into the "theater room." This session is designed to engage children in story telling and learning within a large group, using different Bible stories each week.
- **CATCH ON**—children move to a small group where they discuss real-life experiences, interact with a close-knit group of peers, and participate in a variety of activities that appeal to different learning styles with a Small Group Leader. This is designed to help kids understand how the day's topic/virtue applies to them.
- **PLUG IN**—closure, celebration and conclusion of "plugging in" what we have learned.

Children are dismissed from the worship service. Children check in outside the theater and are picked up in their classrooms.
